(Apprentice Event)

Event Summary:

Drop Dead Time: 25 Minutes

The written test is a timed 25-minute test given to encourage safety at all times when working in the field and during competitions such as the APPA Lineworkers Rodeo.

This written test event takes place on Saturday morning at 8:30 a.m. prior to the opening ceremonies before the field events.

Event Description:

- 1. The written test consists of 50 multiple-choice questions. Each question is weighted equally, and is worth 2 points (out of a total 100).
- 2. The questions will be based on following sections of the 15th edition of the *APPA Safety Manual*:
 - Definitions
 - Section 114: Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), First Aid and Automated External Defibrillators (AED's)
 - Section 115.5: Job Briefings
 - Section 405: Wearing Apparel
 - Section 406: Clothing
 - Section 407: Use and Care of Rubber Gloves
 - Section 503.1-503.7: Vehicle Operations
 - Section 506: Tools and Equipment
 - Section 507: Overhead Distribution and Transmission
 - Section 509: Underground Lines and Equipment

- 4. Supplemental material will **NOT** be allowed during the test; this includes any study guides, the APPA Safety Manual, online resources, cell phones, etc. **Cheating will result in immediate disqualification from the event.**
